Last Minute Stuff - In No Particular Order

01. Visit your dentist, eye doctor and family physician for a complete check up.
02. Pack a small medicine kit in consultation with your family physician for minor ailments and illnesses.
03. Make copies of all documents and certificates you are carrying and leave a set at home. Carry 1 or 2 copies with you also.
04. Write down and keep handy, important phone numbers of contacts and Bank A/c numbers of your parents.
05. Inform the International Office nearest to your University about your arrival date, time etc. well in advance.
06. Keep the phone numbers of the International Office and Student Accommodation separately and handy to call from the airport.
07. Have a hair cut before leaving as it is expensive in Ireland, around 15-30 Euro for a sitting.

Note

Items indicated with a '*' are optional. Condiments and Spices are not covered in the above list.

The above list indicates most of the items you may need for the first few weeks until you settle down in Ireland. This is just a guideline to help you pick and choose the necessary things.

Avoid packing Spices & Condiments along with clothes, lest they should smell nasty when you unpack.

Exercise caution and wisdom to give priority to the items that are a basic necessity, in accordance with the Regulation of the Airlines for the weight of checked-in baggage.

Ireland uses Type G plugs (3-pin, same as UK). Carry enough adaptors as they are more expensive locally.
